### Coonawarra - South Australia

#### Climate: Cool

Coonawarra is renowned as one of Australia's finest wine regions and is particularly known for producing world class red wines especially Cabernet Sauvignon. Its secret lies in a magical marriage of rich red terra rossa soil, limestone, pure underground water and a long cool ripening season for the grapes. Coonawarra is particularly well known for its 'terra rossa' soil which is unique to only a small number of wine growing regions in the world. The cigar-shaped strip of 'terra rossa' is finite, only 21km long and 2km wide, and is all but taken up by vineyards. It's the magical marriage of rich red terra rossa soil, limestone, pure underground water and a long cool ripening season for the grapes that produces world famous Cabernet Sauvignon.

**Rusty Cigar Cabernet Sauvignon – Elegant, dark fruits, black olive and herbaceous notes. Firm tannins. 80% French Oak, 20% American Oak.**

## TASTING NOTES

Grown in what is roundly considered to be the most famous of all new world terroirs, Coonawarra's famous terra rossa soil, The Rusty Cigar is a classic example of refined Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine shows a distinct rich purple colour. Herbaceous aromas are evident with spicy mint and berry flavours which are complimented by hints of leather, tobacco and spicy oak. The rich, full bodied finish is perfectly balanced by generous velvety tannins.
